Coaching at a Distance: A Geographic Challenge

With only two Early Literacy Coaches covering 13 sites across a 2,000-square-mile region, COPESD struggled to provide consistent, in-person coaching. Limited time and travel made one-on-one support rare, creating a gap in timely, meaningful feedback for teachers.



Bringing Reflection and Support into the Classroom

Blumke and Peters adopted Sibme's virtual coaching platform to deliver feedback asynchronously through video. Teachers quickly embraced the tool, using video to reflect on their teaching, identify areas for growth, and receive frequent, flexible support without leaving their classrooms.
